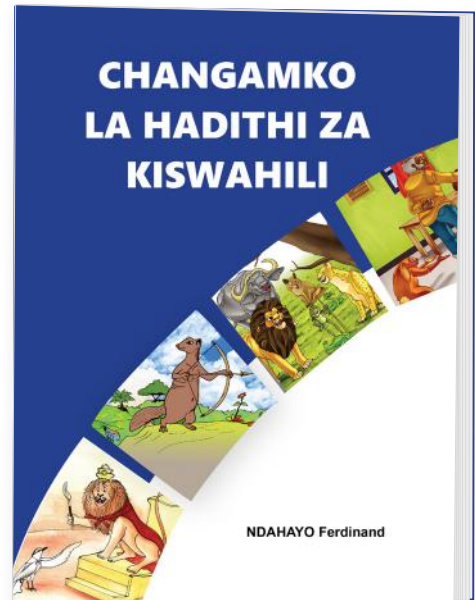
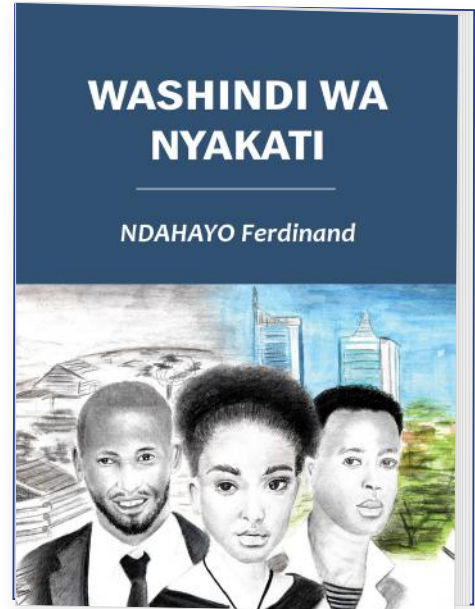
This novel presents three young children; Shema, Kwizera and Mумero who were brilliant and passionate students. After becoming orphans of both parents, they went through different hardships but emerged



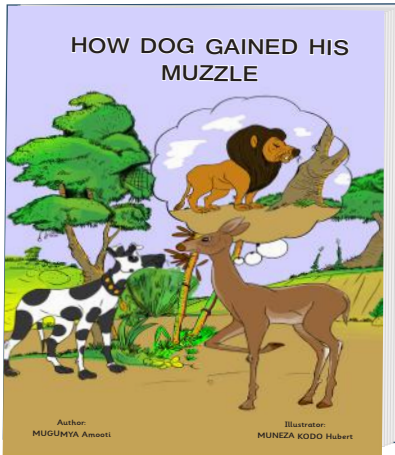

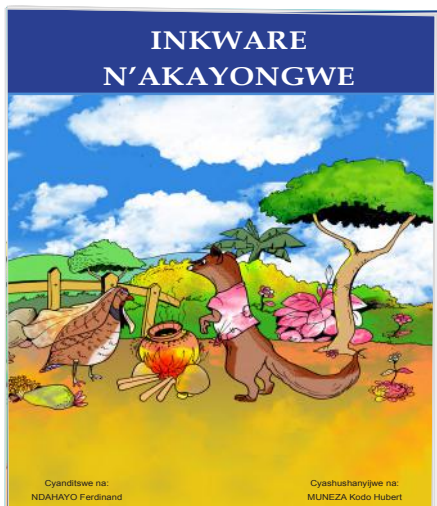
After disregarding their grandfather's advice, the three children faced a challenge in the forest while they were collecting firewood. Who of the three attracted the trouble and how did it end?



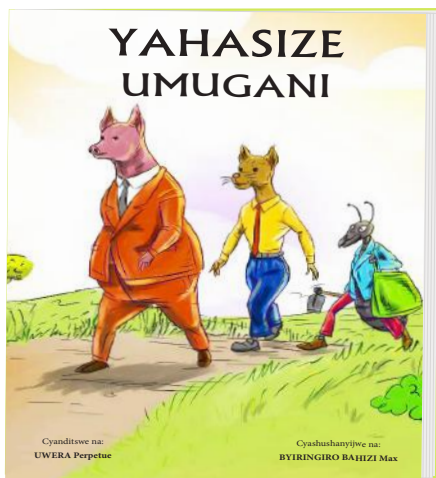

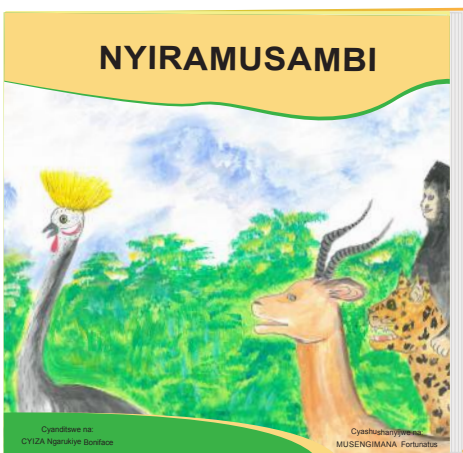
**Safari** is a children story book which captures the curiosity of the children after hearing new information about Safari in Europe. This book helps children to judge before believing something to be real.



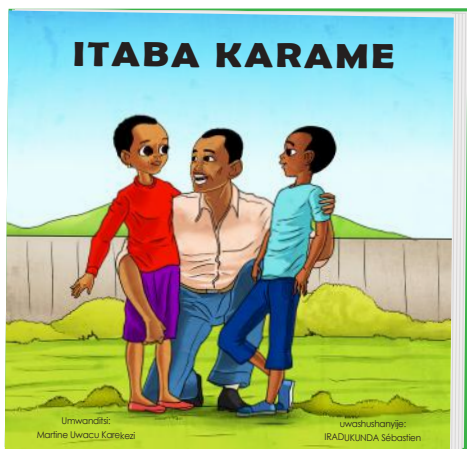
**Agakoko gashonje** is an age story book which helps the readers to know how Agakoko changed into something different.



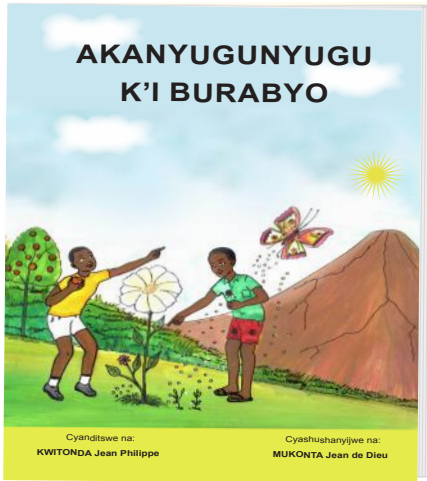
**Kanyamanza** once had a dream to become very rich. Though she went through hardship, she pursued her dream and finally it come true.



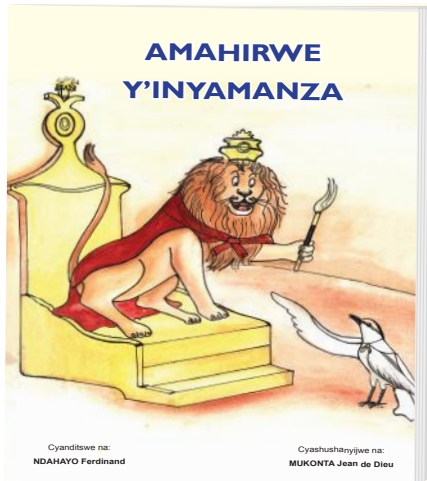

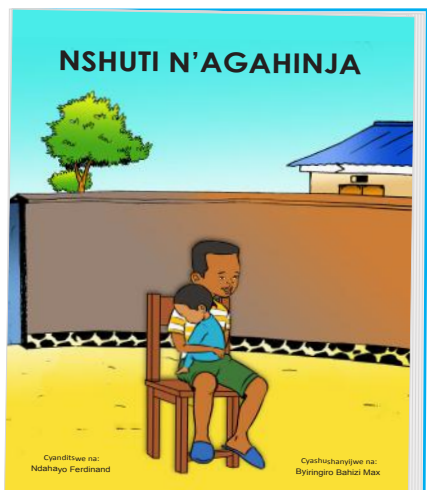

**Akanyugunyugu k'i Burabyo** is a story book about two hills inherited to two young boys to take care of them. Did the boys respect the advice given by their father?



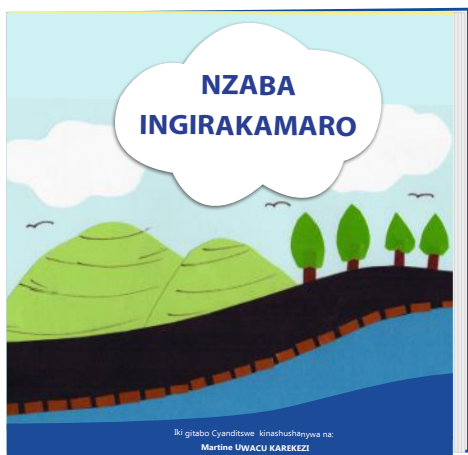

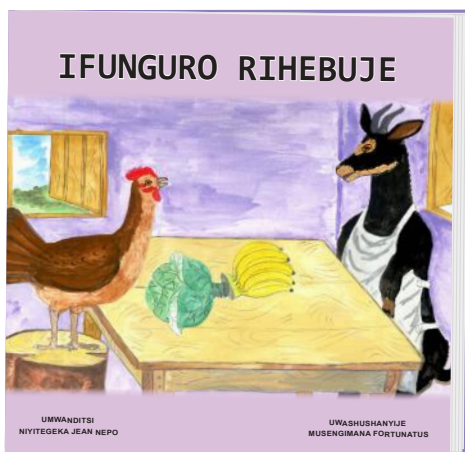
**Nshuti n'Agahinja** is a story about kindness, love and protection. Nshuti can't forsake other children when they face some problems.

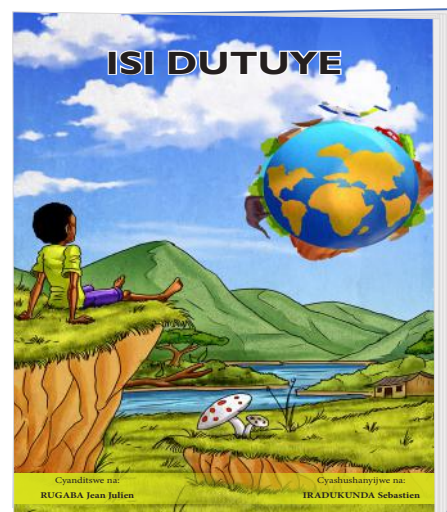
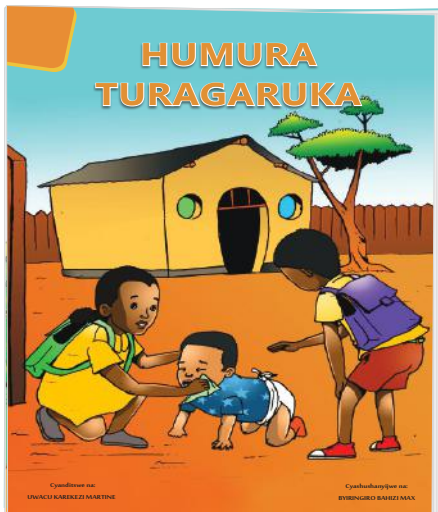
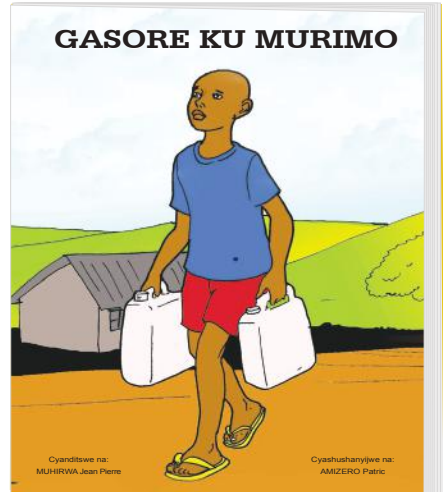
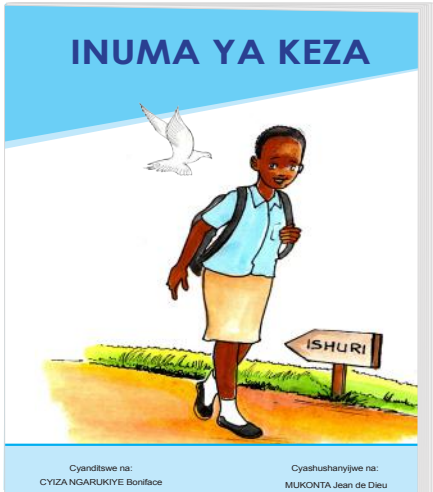
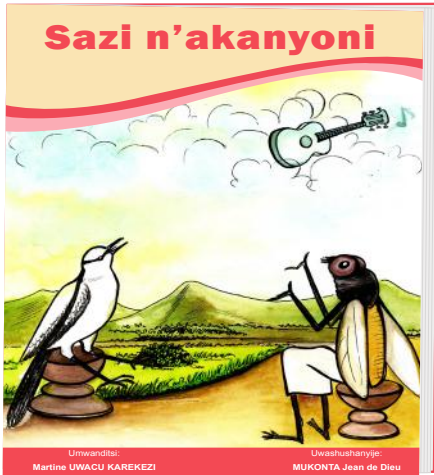
This book presents the commitment of Kaneza in class, her good behavior at home, at school and how she helps her colleagues. When children are reading this book, it motivates them to work hard.

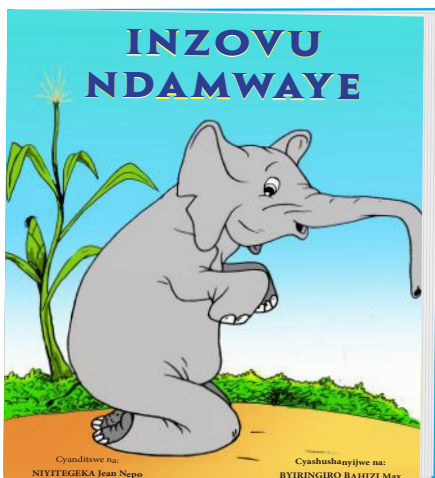
